Why choose the University of Sussex?

- The University of Sussex is ranked 21st in the UK and 151st in the world (Times Higher Education World University Rankings 2022)
- 89% of the University's research activity is considered 'world leading' or 'internationally excellent' (Research Excellence Framework 2021).
- Sussex is ranked 13th in the UK for Business and Economics (THE World University Rankings 2022).
- The University of Sussex is ranked among the top 20 in the UK for Engineering and Technology (Times Higher Education World University Rankings by Subject 2022)
- The campus is home to cutting-edge facilities, including the Future Technologies Lab, which houses leading robotics and technology equipment

Entry requirements for the International Foundation Year

- English language: Academic IELTS for UKVI 5.0 overall (min 5.0 in writing) or equivalent
- Academic: Good High school graduation grades or equivalent.
- Age: Applicants must turn 18 by the 31st of July of the year they are due to complete their ISC course and progress
- 93% of International Study Centre students who completed their course were offered a place on a degree course at the University of Sussex, in 2021

Students need to achieve **50**% overall with a minimum of **40**% in all academic modules to progress to the University of Sussex.
